Ms. Seelbach explained that Family First funds many programs but targets multi-need kids, Help Me Learn is a prevention program for kids with special needs. They help fund programs at the Youth Center, the bridges program at Metzenbaum Center which is partial hospitalization and residential treatment for multi-needs kids is the most expensive program. Ms. Seelbach explained that there has been funding from the State this year to help with multi-needs. Mr. Lennon inquired if the pandemic has affected any budget cuts from the state, to which Help Me Grow had a cut but everything has remained the same right now. There was a one-time grant from children first to help kids that need assistance for laptops and hot spots for schooling. The overall referral numbers are down, but we are still serving the kids that need services. The schools are often the eyes and ears for reporting concerns. There was a brief discussion about possibly being able to utilize the CARES Act funding, but there are criteria that has to be met.
