The Geauga County Board of Commissioners met in special session on July 21, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Chambers located at 12611 Ravenwood Drive, Room B303 in Chardon, Ohio.

It is declared and determined that all formal actions of the Board of County Commissioners concerning and relating to the adoption of all resolutions that were adopted in this meeting, and that all deliberations of the Board of County Commissioners that resulted in such formal action were open to the public and were in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The President of the Board, James W. Dvorak opened the meeting at 10:02 a.m. by leading the Board and audience in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.
