

How to Receive Your PDS Certificate

The Professional Development Series (PDS) Certificate of Completion will be prepared automatically when the student has successfully completed and passed the seven courses. The award will be sent directly to the student.

All courses are considered independent studies, whether done in the distance learning mode or in the classroom as group study.

The Independent Study Program Office will score all tests, issue individual course certificates, maintain students' records, and issue PDS Certificates of Completion.
